## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS / SPECTATORS



We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. Charlbury Town Youth FC is supporting The FA's Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment. Remember children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything.

Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for Parents, Carers and Spectators.

### **I will:**

- **Remember that children play for FUN**
- **Applaud effort and good play as well as success**
- **Always respect the match officials' decisions**
- **Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators' Area**
- **Let the coaches do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do**
- **Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials**
- **Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake – mistakes are part of learning**
- **Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour**

Each team manager has the right to train, manage and play each individual player as they deem best for their team. If parents wish to raise an issue about this they should in the first place contact the manager of the team, who will do their best to resolve the issue. If parents wish to take this further they should contact the Club Welfare Officer or Chairperson, who will mediate over the concerns raised.
